It was an August afternoon in New Delhi. Over a simple lunch, I found myself in quiet conversation with Ms. CJ Collins. Our exchange drifted beyond careers and milestones, into reflections on purpose, legacy, and the quiet, often unseen strength of women in aviation.

Having spent over four decades in aviation and hospitality, I had witnessed these women—resilient, capable, and dedicated—working tirelessly behind the scenes, often unacknowledged. That afternoon lit a spark. It was time to shift the narrative.

We envisioned not just a platform, but a movement. A voice that would honour, empower, and uplift women across India's aviation sector. To form a registered society, we needed ten founding members. We reached out to fifteen women from various verticals of the aviation industry. Every single one said yes.

The Women in Aviation India Chapter was born. The Registrar granted us approval as a non-profit organization dedicated to advancing the role of women in aviation.

A DATE THAT TOOK FLIGHT



On **7th December 2015**, Women in Aviation India was formally launched—an inspiring milestone that beautifully aligned with **International Civil Aviation Day**. We were also honoured by the gracious presence of **Mr. Richard Verma**, **then U.S. Ambassador to India**, adding international goodwill to this significant occasion.

We set out to create a logo that would not merely represent us, but embody every effort, every aspiration behind our movement. At its core lies the bindi—a powerful symbol of Indian womanhood—encircled by the hues of the national tricolor. Saffron, white, and green come together to represent courage, peace, and progress. Thoughtfully conceptualized and brought to life by Lalit Mohan Sharma and his creative team, the logo is not just a design—it is a living emblem of our mission and values.

OUR SLOGAN

Inspired by the visionary call of **Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji —"Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao"**—we set out to amplify our mission with a voice that could resonate across the nation.

By 2017, our identity found powerful expression in the form of a slogan that captured the spirit of every aspiring girl and every empowered woman: "Beti Ki Udaan, Desh Ka Swaabhimaan."

This stirring call was officially unveiled on 8th March 2017, International Women's Day, by Shri Ashok Gajapathi Raju, then Hon'ble Union Minister of Civil Aviation, at Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, New Delhi.

More than words, it became a movement—an anthem for every girl who dares to dream, and every woman who rises with courage. With the unwavering support of the Ministry of Civil Aviation, this message took flight—igniting hearts, inspiring change, and redefining the skies for generations to come.

THE SONG OF OUR SKIES

Soon after, our anthem was born:

"Chhoo Lengi Aasmaan... Bharat ki Betiyan."

Penned by our founding member **Smt. Renu Hussain**, composed and sung by **Shri Krishna Beuria** who was introduced by **Smt. Usha Padhee**, **IAS**, then Joint Secretary, MoCA—this anthem carried a soaring promise to every daughter of India: The sky belongs to you.

It was formally launched at the **WAI Awards 2023 – Giving Wings to Dreams, by Gen. (Dr.) V.K. Singh (Retd.),** then Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Civil Aviation. The melody still echoes. The message is louder than ever.

We were honored to have Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation, as the Chief Guest. His presence was more than symbolic—it reinforced the significance of acknowledging women's impact in aviation.

"Dwelling on the achievement of women in the sector, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Union Minister of Civil Aviation said "This is a landmark day to be remembered. The success of women in aviation is not confined to airports or airplanes but to a much larger ecosystem. 15% of our pilots in India are women which is 3 times more than the global average. But this 15% is not good enough as women have surpassed various odds and stereotypes and I firmly believe there must come a day in India that this 15% must reach 50% of our pilot strength in our country. For this to achieve, we must start from having easy access to STEM education to our young girls in their early education".
